The Priest - A Mysterious Being and Giver of the Eucharist

Abstract

The Holy Eucharist is regarded as the "sacrament of sacraments" in the Orthodox tradition and its commitment represents the Christ's continuous sacrifce for forgiveness of sins and eternal life acquisition.
